## ESC Member Federations

Dear Sir,

The activities of the Kosovo Shooting Federation are increased lately in order to be accepted in full legal membership of international shooting organizations.

Regarding this issue, the Serbian Shooting Sport Federation finds it necessary to notify you as follows:

The Serbian Shooting Sport Federation is full member of International Shooting Union (UIT) since 1909, whose legal successor is the ISSF, as well as full member of the European Shooting Confederation.

Kosovo and Metohija is the southern Serbian province and an integral part of the Republic of Serbia, in accordance with Resolution 1244 of the United Nations Security Council since 10th June of 1999 and under the jurisdiction of UN-UMNIK and EU-EULEX missions.

The unilateral declaration of Republic of Kosovo on 17th February of 2008 is not recognized by the Republic of Serbia or by all members of UN and EU.

Because of this, the Serbian Shooting Sport Federation, as the national sports federation with its statutory rights for the whole territory of the Republic of Serbia is not in conformity with acceptance of shooting organizations from Kosovo and Metohija in full membership of international shooting organizations until its status is permanently solved by the UN.

Due to these facts, we suggest that management bodies do not put on the agenda the question of potential acceptance of any shooting organization from this territory in full membership of international shooting organizations.
